General Information

- Miss El Reno Pageant is an all-natural pageant promoting self-confidence, hometown pride, leadership, and community involvement
- Each division will have one titleholder who will receive an official crown and sash
- Pageant entry fee is \$45 ~
 \$10.00 off if entered and paid by February 1, 2020
- Everyone in attendance at the pageant, except for the adult in the dressing room with each contestant, will be required to purchase a ticket. General admission and VIP tickets will be available for pre-order. Souvenir programs are \$10 each
- Official pageant t-shirts are \$20 \$24 and must be pre-ordered by March 5, 2020
- Good Luck ads for the souvenir program can be purchased for \$25 - \$75. Deadline is March 5, 2020
- Each contestant is required to sell a minimum of three (3) advertisements in the pageant program. If she does not, she is required to pay the cost of three quarter - page ads (\$150 minimum) in addition to the registration fee. Backstage Rules

- Contestants are responsible for their own belongings
- Do not bring valuable items
- No food or drink in the dressing areas
- One female parent/guardian must be with each contestant. Sisters who are entered in different divisions of the pageant must have a different adult since dressing rooms will not be in the same place
 - Special arrangements may be made for a father or male guardian who needs to be with his contestant. Please call the Chamber no later than March 5, 2020, to make the arrangements. 262.1188
- Access to electrical outlets in very limited. Please arrive with your contestant's hair ready for competition
- Backstage parent/guardian may watch the pageant from back of auditorium. As soon as your contestant completes her turn on stage please return to the stage entrance to retrieve your contestant
- Contestants must be in the dressing rooms 30 minutes before her pageant starts
- No photography or videography is allowed in the dressing rooms or portrait areas
 - Photos and videos may be taken in the hallway between the dressing rooms and stage, or in the auditorium after the pageant



Official Rules

- Contestants must be a resident of El Reno or attend Banner, El Reno, Darlington, Legacy, Maple, Riverside, or Sacred Heart schools
- ♦ The pageant is for girls and young ladies
- Contestants must compete in the division based on her age as of April 1, 2020
- An adult may be on stage with contestants in the Mini Miss El Reno and Tiny Miss El Reno Pageant
- Adults on stage with contestants must wear clothing which does not distract the judges or audience from the contestants. Clothing should cover cleavage, mid-section, and backside when bending, squatting, or other position needed to assist the contestant
- The adult designated for backstage during the pageant must wear the pageant identification badge provided at no charge by pageant officials
- All decisions of the judges are final and binding
- All pageant fees are non-refundable
- Photographs and videos taken of all contestants during the pageant and other Chamber events may be used for promotional purposes
- The pageant has an official photographer for portraits and competition pictures. Photo packages may be purchased directly from the photographer
- All audience members must be seated during the pageant



Miss El Reno Job Description and Events

The following are qualities and expectations for our new Miss El Reno titleholders

- Outgoing, approachable, energetic, kind, patient, appreciative, willing to help as needed
- Representative of the El Reno Chamber of Commerce
- Participate in the Veterans Day Parade and honor ceremony (November)
- Assist with Annual Chamber of Commerce Awards Banquet with tasks appropriate to the titleholder's age
- Help with fundraising for pageant and other Chamber projects
- Agree to make appearances at local events to be determined by the Chamber and coordinated with the titleholder's schedule
- Titleholder's T-shirt will be provided and may be required to be worn with crown and sash at events
- Titleholders must have Chamber approval to wear sash and crown at events not sponsored by the Chamber
- Mini Miss El Reno and Tiny Miss El Reno may have different event and appearance schedules which are appropriate to the young ladies' ages
- A parent/guardian must accompany titleholder at any event or appearance



Competition Wardrobe Guidelines

Wardrobe should not be expensive. Contestants must wear *age appropriate* attire that makes her feel comfortable, happy, and beautiful

Party Dress

- All party dresses must cover the contestant's chest, midriff, and backside. School dress codes are a good guideline
- Examples of party dress might be an Easter dress,
 First Communion dress, or dress for a dance

Outfit of Choice

- An everyday outfit that expresses the contestant's unique personality
- Examples of outfit of choice include a sports uniform, dance costume, dress up clothes, favorite school outfit
- Props may be used but must be managed by the contestant on stage

On-Stage Question (for Tiny, Petite, Young & Teen)

- Each contestant will be asked one age appropriate randomly drawn question
- Questions will come from a variety of areas including, but not limited to, the contestant's favorite things, activities, family, pets, and future plans
